3. The IQAC should meet at least once in every quarter.

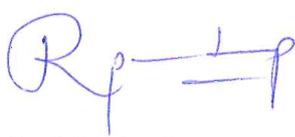
Goals

1. To develop a quality system for conscious, consistent and catalytic programmed action to improve the academic and administrative performance of the University;
2. To promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices.

The IQAC shall have the following functions:

1. Development and application of quality benchmarks/parameters for the various academic and administrative activities of the University;
2. Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment conducive for quality education and faculty maturation to adopt the required knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process;
3. Arrangement for feedback responses from students, parents and other stakeholders on quality related institutional processes;
4. Dissemination of information on the various quality parameters of higher education; • Organization of inter and intra University workshops, seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles;
5. Documentation of the various programmes/activities of the University, leading to quality improvement;
6. Acting as a nodal agency of the University for coordinating quality-related activities, including adoption and dissemination of good practices;

7. Development and maintenance of Institutional database through MIS for the purpose of maintaining /enhancing the institutional quality;
8. Development of Quality Culture in University;
9. Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) of the University based on the quality parameters/assessment criteria developed by the relevant quality assurance body (like NAAC, NBA, AB) in the prescribed format;
10. Bi-annual development of Quality Radars (QRs) and Ranking of Integral Units of HEIs based on the AQAR; • Interaction with SQACs in the pre and post accreditation quality assessment, sustenance and enhancement endeavours.
