Reconstitution of the Anti-Ragging Committee

In continuation of Notification No. PU/VC/R/2026/004 dated January 12, 2026, and in accordance with the University Grants Commission (UGC) Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, as amended from time to time, the Anti-Ragging Committee of Plaksha University is hereby reconstituted with immediate effect.

Roles and Responsibilities:

The Anti-Ragging Committee shall be responsible for ensuring compliance with the provisions of the **UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009**, as amended from time to time.

The Committee shall, inter alia:

1. Ensure compliance with the provisions of the UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations and all applicable laws, directions and guidelines concerning prevention and prohibition of ragging.
2. The Anti-Ragging Squad shall be constituted separately in accordance with the applicable UGC Regulations.
3. Monitor and oversee the functioning and performance of the Anti-Ragging Squad in preventing ragging in the University.
4. Formulate and periodically review strategies, preventive measures and action plans for maintaining a ragging-free campus.
5. Promote awareness and sensitization regarding the prohibition of ragging, its consequences and the mechanisms available for reporting incidents.
6. Review reports and recommendations received from the Anti-Ragging Squad concerning incidents or suspected incidents of ragging and take or recommend appropriate action in accordance with the UGC Regulations and applicable law.
7. Ensure that any inquiry or action concerning an alleged incident of ragging is undertaken in accordance with the principles of natural justice, including providing the concerned student(s) with a reasonable opportunity to be heard, wherever applicable.
8. Ensure that complaints or information concerning ragging are dealt with promptly, fairly and in accordance with the procedure prescribed under the applicable UGC Regulations and law.



Tenure, Quorum, and Meeting Frequency

1. Tenure: The term of office of the members of the Committee shall be one year from the date of issuance of this Notification, unless otherwise reconstituted earlier by the University.
2. Quorum: The quorum of the committee shall be two-thirds of the total number of members of the committee.
3. Meeting Frequency: The Committee shall meet as and when required; however, at least one meeting shall be convened in each academic year.

This Notification supersedes all previous orders/notifications relating to the constitution of the Anti-Ragging Committee to the extent of any inconsistency.

All concerned shall take note of the above and ensure due compliance.
