The composition of the SEDG cell is as follows:

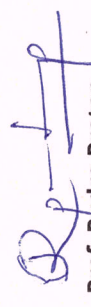

Tenure, quorum and frequency:

Objectives of SEDGs Cell:

1. To protect all the constitutional rights of the SEDGs students.
2. To provide comprehensive socio-emotional and academic support, along with mentoring, to SEDGs students through dedicated counseling and monitoring programs.
3. To ensure effective implementation and monitoring of orientation and bridge courses, specifically designed to support SEDGs students.
4. To ensure the implementation of programs aimed at increasing the participation of SEDGs students in academic activities.
5. To ensure the proper enforcement of government policies, including reservation quotas and schemes, to support the academic and personal development of SEDGs students.
6. To facilitate appropriate outreach programs, helping SEDGs students access various educational and academic opportunities.
7. To ensure the implementation of preventive measures, laws against discrimination, and safeguards to protect students from the SEDGs categories, in accordance with relevant legal provisions.
8. To address and resolve grievances and complaints from SEDGs students within 15 days through a Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC), maintaining the safety, privacy, and dignity of the complainants.
