

Notification: Student's Grievances Redressal Committee (SGRC)

In continuation of Notification No. PU/VC/R/2025/065, dated 01 August 2025, the "Student's Grievances Redressal Committee (SGRC)" of Plaksha University has been revised as follows:

Responsibility of SGRC:

1. When considering the grievances before it, the SGRC shall follow the principles of natural justice.
2. The SGRC shall send its report, with any recommendations, to the competent authority of the institution concerned and a copy to the aggrieved student, preferably within 15 working days of receipt of the complaint.
3. Any student aggrieved by the decision of the Students' Grievance Redressal Committee may prefer an appeal to the Ombudsperson within fifteen days of receipt of that decision.
4. On receipt of a complaint, the institution shall refer it to the appropriate Students' Grievance Redressal Committee, along with its comments, within 15 days of receipt of the complaint.
5. The Students' Grievance Redressal Committee, as the case may be, shall fix a date for the hearing of the complaint, which shall be communicated to the university and the aggrieved student.
6. An aggrieved student may appear in person or authorize a representative to present the case.



Note:

If grievances are not resolved by the Students' Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC) within the time period specified in the regulations, they may be referred to the Ombudsperson appointed by the university.

Tenure, Quorum and frequency of Meeting:

1. The term of the chairperson and members shall be for two years.
2. The term of the special invitee shall be for one year.
3. The quorum for the meeting, including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.
4. The committee shall meet as necessary.
5. The term of the special invitee shall be for one year.
